We are also preparing for our upcoming charge conference, and have Administrative Council meeting this month, under our new organizational structure.

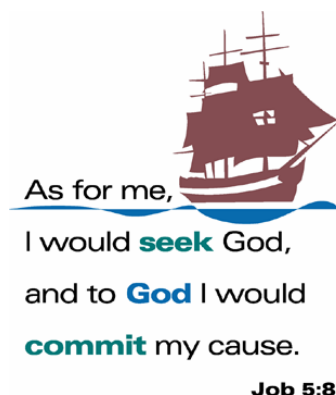

Officers agreed to serve in their current positions in 2010.

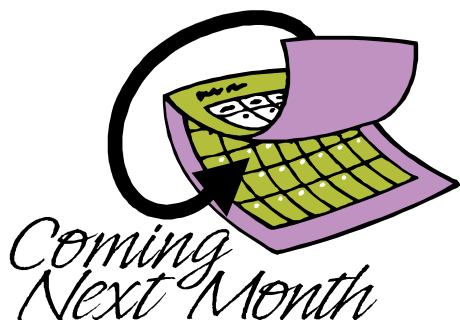

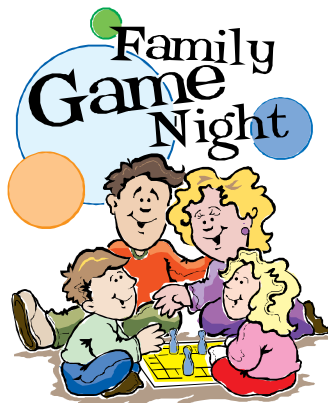


### TRICK OR TREATING FOR CANNED GOODS
